Timothy Christian School Kicks Off Campaign!

On April 24th Timothy Christian School kicked off their \$2.5M campaign at a reception in the school gymnasium at 7pm. Approximately 200 donors and community leaders were in attendance.

“This is an overwhelming response by the community”, said Campaign Chair Sion Jones. “We have been working so hard over the last four months and tonight marks a major milestone in the campaign”.

During the Campaign Kick-off, Sion Jones announced that the campaign had surpassed the 50% mark, with \$1,267,950 raised. The campaign team will now move into a more public and active phase of the campaign over the next few months.

“This is an incredible night of Timothy Christian School”, said Kevin Eisses, Chair of the Board of Directors. Mr. Eisses went on to say, “Success of this campaign will ensure that Timothy Christian School can continue to provide affordable Christian education to the community”.

Timothy Christian School built a new campus in 2005 at 750 Essa Road in Barrie at a total cost of \$7M. Construction of the new facility was fully funded by private donations, promissory notes and a small mortgage. The campaign is focused on reducing the promissory notes and a portion of the mortgage.

Timothy Christian School is an interdenominational, Christ-centered educational environment, which provides for the academic, spiritual, physical, and social development of children. As a non-profit elementary school, serving children ages 4 to 13, Timothy Christian School is fully funded through tuition and donations. Timothy Christian School receives no government funding. “We are proud of our long standing history in Barrie”, said the school’s principal, Mr. Andy Straatsma. “We strive to meet and surpass ministry requirements and follow much of the provincial curriculum. We supplement our course of instruction with curricular resources and textbooks that are written from a Christian perspective”. Currently Timothy Christian School has a student population of 230 students, and provides classes from JK through Grade 8.

Timothy also provides space to two separately operated organizations, namely Unity Christian High School and Harvest Bible Chapel.
