#### Grade 8 Students and Transition to High School

A reminder to all grade 8 parents that November through January are when most local high schools have their open house/parent information evenings. Since we are a Christian elementary school and we support Christian high school, we send all of our grade 8 students to the Unity Christian High School "Unity Day" on November 1st to get an idea of what high school would be like. Over 50% of our grade 8 students consistently attend Unity so that makes TCS an official feeder school for Unity. Our TCS board is very supportive of Christian education beyond grade 8 and thus our TCS grade 8 students consistently participate in the Unity Day each year.

We also understand that some of the grade 8 students will attend other local high schools and since this is usually a smaller group, we pass on information as we get it to those interested or direct parents where they can get this information.

If your child will be attending a local public or catholic high school we encourage you to check the Simcoe County Public or Catholic Board websites. All the grade nine information evenings or open house events are listed for each high school on the websites so we encourage our grade 8 parents to stay connected and check for upcoming grade 9 events.
