<u>TCS Always Learning from Others...Christian School Principal's visiting Finland next week to Learn and Grow Professionally!</u> — From Mr. Berg, TCS, Principal

Timothy Christian School and the OCSAA (Ontario Christian School Administrators Association) have a lot in common – they both love learning from other schools what leading edge programs can look like. The OCSAA - that most Christian school principals are members of, has been doing some fundraising for a special professional development opportunities over the past few years. Most of the donations come from wealthy Christian donors who are long term supporters of Christian education but their own members have also made donations over the years to support this project.

The 50 – 80 thousand raised recently will go towards covering the majority of the cost of sending 35 Christian school leaders (from Christian schools across Ontario) to Finland for a week to learn from the schools there. I was very blessed to be included in this grant last Spring and the TCS board approved this professional development for next week. The grant covers the majority of the cost of this trip with only a small amount covered by TCS. So, due to this grant, the 35 Christian school leaders who applied and were approved for the grant, will be spending next week in Finland visiting and learning from several schools about why their educational system has been so successful over the years. The educational/professional development tour will include visiting/touring a different schools in Helsinki every day from Monday to Thursday and workshops on the Thursday and Friday gleaning what works in education in Finland.

It is one of those very rare learning opportunities / professional development that only came along due to the fundraising through the principal organization.

I very much look forward to growing and learning and gleaning best practices for TCS throughout next week. Mrs. Goodnough, our vice principal, will be in charge for the week that I am away.

When you have a chance to review of school vision statement at the front of the school when you walk in, you will see meaningful, stretching professional development connects very well with our TCS vision statement which pushes us to be 'dynamic, vibrant and leading edge' providing really good education that lands on a clear Christian worldview. It is very exciting to live this vision out practically by learning from the success Finland is experiencing.

Homework Highlights

Tests and Major Assignments: Grades 3-8

All tests, major auizzes and major assignments will be published in the weekly school newsletter under the grades 3, 4 & 5 homework section by the classroom teacher five school days prior to the due date and on Schoology for grades 6-8.

Review Sheets/Study Sheets:

All grade 3 – 8 teachers will give out a review sheet/ study sheet summarizing the key areas of a test a minimum of **three days** before the test date. These will be generated by the teacher on the content being covered.

Review sheets/study sheets will be taken up in class by the teacher a minimum of two days before the test so the students go home with the proper information.

Review sheets/study sheets will have a direct connection to what is being tested. More may be expected on a study sheet but a test will not have items that are not on a review/study sheet.

For Grade 6—8 Parents: All assignments, tests and homework related items will now be found on Schoology (an online homework program). The grades 6-8 teachers will be sending information with their students to inform parents how this will work for the upcoming year and how parents can check in.


