Snow Day Reminders

A reminder that this year the TCS board is running a trial year in keeping school open when buses are cancelled. A few reminders as we get into the snow season and the potential of cancelled buses:

- As in years past, if the TCS buses are cancelled the TCS office will send out an email to all our parents around 6:15am. Sinton Landmark most often cancels their buses shortly after Simcoe County buses are cancelled. Note: You can always check the Simcoe County District School Board website if you are ever wondering as the call is usually made between 5:30am 6:15am. There is a bit of a delay between Simcoe cancelling and Sinton cancelling but it is always connected as one waits for the other.
- Please make sure that Bethany at the front office has your current email address as that is how we will communicate cancelled buses or school closures
- In this upcoming trial year, the majority of the time TCS buses are cancelled, school will remain open and TCS staff will be at school supervising the students who arrive for the day
- Please note that no new material will be taught on those bus cancelled days because the majority of TCS students will be missing
- When buses are cancelled, it will be the responsibility of the parents to drive students to school after 8:30 and pick them up before 3:30
- Similar to how local public and catholic schools operate, when major highways like 27 and 400 are closed then the call could be made that both the buses are cancelled and school will be closed. Please look for either of these emails coming at about 6:15 6:30...either "Buses are cancelled but school is open" or "Buses are cancelled and school is closed for the day".

NOTE: We have been made aware that a few of our families did not receive the emails regarding bus cancellations. If you did not receive the email notice for the past 2 bus cancellation days, please contact the office as soon as possible so that Bethany can add you to the email list.


