- The Board recently invited a full audit of TCS and the Auditors (Morrison CPA in Barrie) presented the results of the audit at the Board meeting. It was a positive review, they gave great feedback with some options to consider for future years. The Board would like to thank our financial administrator, Sheri Cantle, for her great work preparing for the audit and for having the finances in such good order.
- A number of families still need to submit their PITCH forms/information for 2018. Their registration in January will not be complete until their PITCH forms, with both the form and the credit card numbers are received along with the re-registration.
- 3. The new strategic plan will begin being developed in April with community input evenings.
- 4. The Board hosted a staff lunch on January 9 to thank the TCS staff for all their good work. The Board does this on a yearly basis for the TCS staff.


Grade 7 Fundraiser
