Progress Reports - going to parents on November 8!

A reminder that TCS student progress reports will be coming home to parents on November 8th. These reports are an update early in the fall, halfway between the start of the school year and the first term report cards that come out in January, to check-in with parents on how their child is doing.

These reports are a checklist style that gives parents a high level (non-detailed) view of how your student is doing. It is intended as a high level summary thus far. Please note the reason we have the **parent/teacher interviews set for the evenings of November 13 and 16** is to allow the face-to-face conversations with the teacher to give more detail. That way early in the third month of the school year you will have received both a written summary as well as verbal summary via face-to-face meeting with your child's teacher.

Parents—we look forward to 100% participation at our November parent/teacher interviews so we can partner in the educational journey of your child early in this school year. Please make every effort to meet with your teacher on November 13 or 16.
