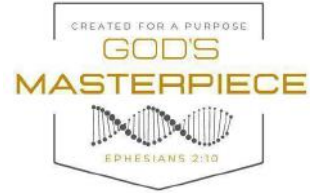

PITCH OPPORTUNITIES: Limited to adults only

Thank you parents, grandparents, etc. for being eager to help out and earn family PITCH hours! Please note that since PITCH hours have a correlated dollar value, and possible insurance / safety issues, we limit PITCH opportunities to only adults (unless specified that an opportunity is suitable for students or tasks are being done at home). Younger pre-school children are not to accompany parents, unless the child is in a stroller and will be asleep or need little to no interaction with the parent (meaning infants younger than 3 months or so), as older children tend to need attention and support to stay quiet for a period of time. *When a parent volunteers for a PITCH opportunity we need to know that that parent's full attention is on the task at hand and not being distracted by a younger child.* Thank you for your understanding with this and for being eager to volunteer and complete your PITCH required hours!

Logging your PITCH hours

Please be aware that it is each family's responsibility to track and log their own PITCH hours. To enter your hours, please follow these instructions:

- Log onto Sycamore (TCS School Id: 3982), On the left side click "My School", "My Service Logs"
- Click "NEW" button on the right side, Complete the form *choosing the appropriate heading*
- Click "Save"... entered hours are pending until approved by the PITCH committee
- Families that are required to complete ONLY 15 hours, please be sure to log the SPECIAL PITCH AUTHORIZATION of 10 hours (these are the hours granted to you so you only need to complete 15 hours in total).

Remember, each family is permitted to enter 2.5 hours for attending Society meetings (even if you aren't a member!).
