#### **Board Reflections from the November 2018 Meeting**

- The board is in the process of drafting a TCS family values statement
- A December 1st deadline has been set to have all parent post-dated cheques or visa numbers to the Pitch committee. Completion of this paperwork will now be connected to registration in January as well.
- The board has initiated a financial audit to be done on TCS in a proactive effort to ensure that we are following best financial practices. This audit is currently in progress.
- The board processed all the results of the parent survey conducted by Ontario Alliance of Christian Schools (now called Edvance) in June of 2018, This survey is part of the 5 - 7 year evaluation cycle which is normally done. The results were very positive and will be shared at the membership meeting and in the In Touch newsletter.
- The year end financial summary was presented to the board by the Finance committee. This was also very positive.
- 65 New Members were approved to join the TCS Christian School Society Membership at the November meeting.



#### STUDENT HOMEWORK GUIDELINES

Tests and Major Assignments:

- All tests, major quizzes and major assignments will be published online or in the weekly school newsletter under the grades 4 – 8 homework section by the classroom teacher five school days prior to the due date
- Going forward, teacher emails or classroom newsletters will be a secondary way to publish tests, quizzes or major assignments, but the school newsletter or online for grades 6 — 8 will be the priority first line of communication with parents when publishing tests, quizzes or major assignments
- With no exception, no tests, major quizzes or major assignments will be given that are not published in the school newsletter five days before the due date

Review Sheets/Study Sheets:

- All grade 4 8 teachers will give out a review sheet/study sheet summarizing the key areas of a test a minimum of three days before the test date. These will be generated by the teacher on the content being covered.
- Review sheets/study sheets will be taken up in class by the teacher
  a minimum of two days before the test so the students go home
  with the proper information.
