Our Grade 6 & 7 teachers going to Kolkata, India for nine days in October

Last winter, Miss Winger (grade 7) and Mr. Wilcox (grade 6) were approached by Emmanuel Baptist Church to bring leadership to a short-term missions trip to India in October. October was the timing that fit the ministries they are working with in Kolkata. This was presented to the TCS Board of Directors back in January and the Board looked at the benefits of our two teachers being part of this trip as well as how this experience had the potential to stretch our students (with how it changes teachers and what they bring back to the classroom from this experience).

opportunity for these teachers to walk the walk and become global citizens in the Kingdom of God and the chance to stretch a teacher in worldview... the Board felt it was a great chance for these teachers to grow and be part of a bigger redemption project in our community. With this on the heels of the very deep and meaningful grade 6-8 project on global awareness in supporting refugees in Barrie last year—it was such a good fit!

Our grade 6 and 7 teachers will be a part of a team who will spend time in Kolkata, India running camps for children and youth in and outside the city. They will also work alongside ministries that seek to rescue women and children from sextrafficking in the city.

We look forward to hearing about this trip from our two teachers at the November 21st TCS Society meeting. The TCS Board of Directors looks at these requests and reviews each individually to ensure there is a deep student benefit and significant professional growth for the teachers involved. This one allowed for such a wonderful depth in experience (with very minimal cost to the school) for our teachers that we saw a good fit.

We wish Miss Winger and Mr. Wilcox blessings as they leave for India on Friday, October 18th and return the weekend of November 2nd. Mrs. Kloosterman and Mrs. Brown will be supply teaching for them as they are away.

Bus Monitors all Trained and Ready!

To help in keeping the buses well monitored, we have also trained 15 bus monitors over the past couple weeks. There will be three monitors on each bus who will help the bus drivers with safety and be the eyes on the bus to support the principal should behaviour situations come up. These monitors were trained by the Barrie Police last week on safety and how to evacuate the bus in an emergency. Bus monitors will get their safety vests this week and officially begin their duties this week.

Ensuring a Healthy School Culture at TCS

During the week of October 15th, teachers in grades 3-8 will have students fill out a Student Culture Survey on how things are going in each classroom. This is a short one-page questionnaire for students that will ask:

- Is there is someone in your class who is being picked on or bothered on a regular basis?
- What are the names of the students who are not being kind to these students?
- Who the students are who are being picked on?

What happens to this information?

The classroom teacher summarizes this student feedback and hands a summary of these student comments to the principal. The teacher and the principal together review the student feedback. If there are one or two students in a class that require a conversation with the teacher or the principal, that happens as follow-up of this survey and boundaries are put in place. If needed, at certain times, parents of certain students are brought into a meeting as well to ensure boundaries are both put in place and followed through. This keeps both the classroom teacher and the principal in the loop on the pulse of each class in grades 3-8. Since these surveys are private and confidential, they are also accurate and authentic and no one knows who wrote what comments.

Why is this important?

Because students are so precious to us and we don't tolerate teasing or put downs at TCS and will do all we can, including student surveys several times a year, to deal with and follow-up on student situations.

Bully Awareness Month in November

TCS staff will be spending time throughout the month of November on bullying awareness that includes reminding our students of the deep Culture of Caring that we have at TCS. The Bullying Awareness assembly is on November 22, but there will be a focus on this throughout November as well.


Cross Country
