Elections Canada Renting TCS Gym next Mon., Oct 21st

Just an FYI for all our TCS parents... TCS will be a polling station on Election Day next Monday, October 21st for the federal election. The gym will be off limits for all staff and students as voters will be arriving to vote at 9:30am and throughout the day and evening at TCS.

We will have added security from 8am-4pm next Monday to ensure students are safe while people vote in the TCS Gym. Elections Canada will provide a door person to ensure the voters know where to go and where to vote (voters will not be permitted in our hallways where students are in class that day). In addition to this, TCS has hired additional personnel to float through the hallways to ensure student safety.

Allowing Elections Canada to rent our gym is great promotion to potential parents in our neighbourhood allowing them to walk in our building and see who we are. It is also good to do our civic duty and be part of the excitement of this federal election by hosting a polling station.

Some of you remember the senior team focused on learning and supporting Syrian refugees throughout the curriculum and hosted several sports afternoons and dinners at the school for refugees in Barrie. This also included our grade 6-8 students publishing a booklet that would help local churches support refugees as they come to Barrie. Thank you to Mrs. Covert who took the time to nominate our senior staff for this award. It was announced last week that they won! There will be an awards dinner on the evening of October 24th that several of our TCS staff will be attending to receive this honour. Congratulations grade 6-8 team and well done!

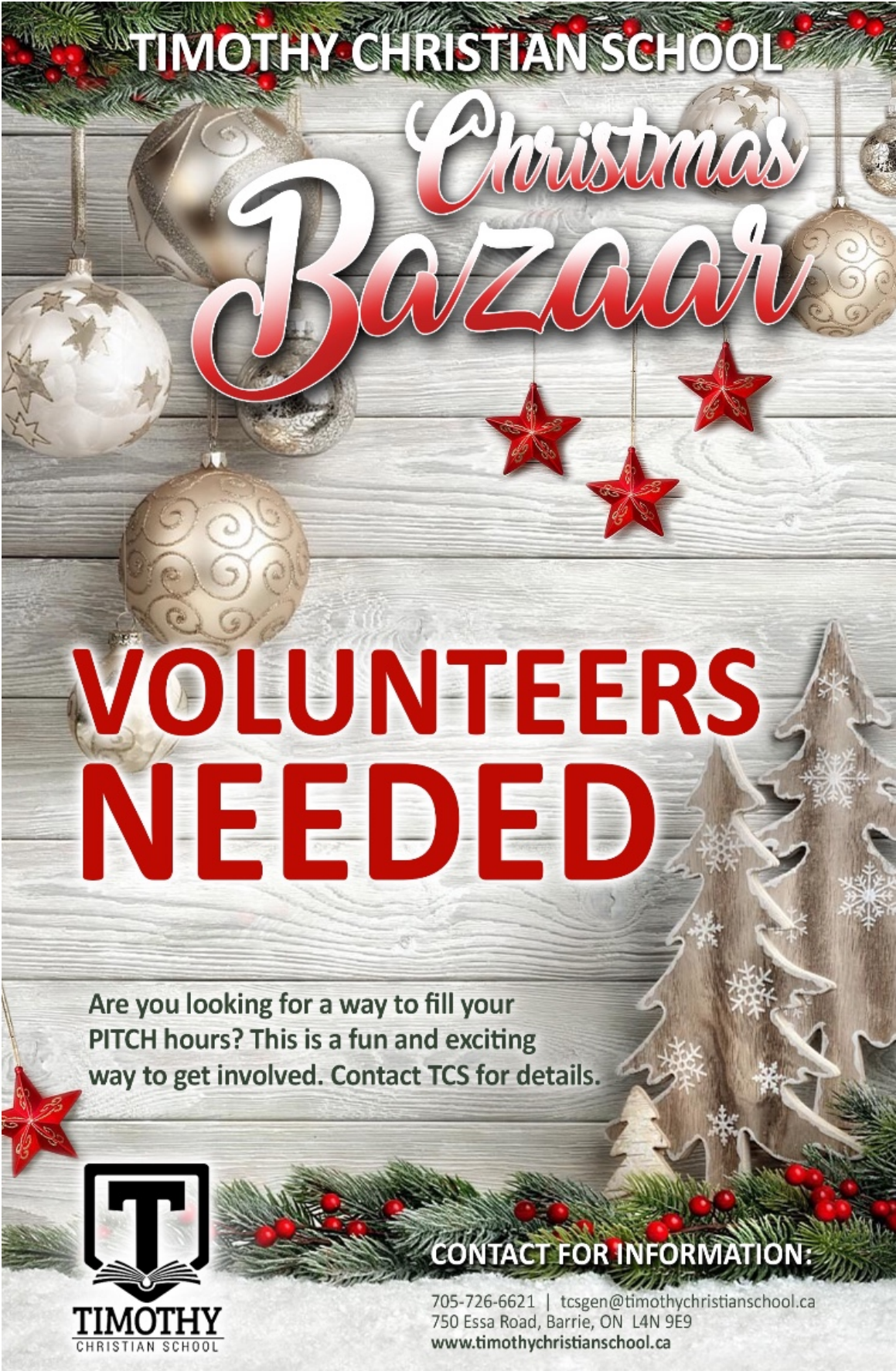
