Simcoe County Schools Not Face to Face Yet... Hopefully Soon!

As you are now aware from the memo sent from the TCS office last Wednesday evening, Simcoe County *was not* one of the areas allowed back to school this week. It was buried deep in the news and took many of us until late in the day to find the announcement. Like many of our parents, we were also hoping to be one of the districts allowed back to school today.

Being that there has been a significant outbreak at one of our local retirement communities in Barrie and that the overall number of cases in Ontario is still high (although coming down), it is understandable that the province wanted to be cautious and careful. Although no return to school timeline has been given for Simcoe County schools, we are anticipating a two-week delay and are hopeful for February 8th as a potential (if the province is keeping to a two-week delay pattern).

We know as we launch into week three, the extra workload on the home front is challenging and we greatly appreciate your continued partnership. On the school front we are continuously trying to be 'clear and attainable' with all of the work and look forward to hearing your feedback in the short parent check-in this week (information below).

Please take a few minutes to fill out the survey and give us feedback on the areas listed. The anonymous feedback will be summarized for the teaching staff later this week to give them a sense of how the online program is going. This is our second time asking for parent feedback as our

teaching staff have already completed a phone survey calling all of our parents and received positive feedback, but we also wanted to receive feedback this way as well in case anything was missed.

We understand that each household is at a different place as we step into week three. Based on the teacher phone survey, many of our parents are into a good routine and coping well on the home front, others are feeling the heavy weight of week three with trying to work with several primary children at home, and a few are significantly stretched and may be looking for help. The survey will help us deploy any extra EA help we can and look at big picture areas we might be able to shift in to help.

As a staff we have talked extensively about all JK - grade 8 schoolwork being *'clear and attainable'* for our parents and students and look forward to hearing from you via this survey.



In the midst of these busy times, staff members now are planning to write report cards for students at TCS. The report cards this year will look a bit different as we are formatting them into the new Sycamore School system and had to change the look a bit.

Our regularly scheduled report card writing day (Professional Activity Day) is set for next Monday, February 1st. TCS teachers will be setting this day aside to write report cards for TCS students as published in the TCS School Calendar that was sent out in August.

Note: Being that teachers will be writing report cards, there will not be homework posted for Monday, February 1st just like any normal PA day. Instead, that week the assignments, videos and homework will be posted for grades 1 - 8 on Tuesday, February 2nd and for JK and SK on Wednesday, February 3rd. Report cards will be sent home on Wednesday, February 10th to parents for term one.

Re-Registration for September 2021 – This Week Yet!

Parents have informed us that the registration process using our new office software "Sycamore School" is quick, efficient and can be completed in under 10 minutes for most families. You have the option to pay the \$300 deposit by cheque, pre-authorized withdrawal, or e-transfer. We encourage all of our existing TCS families to confirm early for this fall to avoid waiting lists as we do anticipate many former TCS families, who took the year off this year due to COVID, to return and have been processing a lot of interest from new families for this fall as well.
