Projected student numbers for Trinity for September 2026:

JK - 8...projected numbers are between 360 - 370 students

9 - 12...We presently have 97 students who have registered and we could realistically top 100 students in 9 - 12 next year. We are presently working on two classes for grade 9.

The above student numbers are *students/families who have actually registered, and* who we are presently processing.
